Information Sheet for ELAC Parents 2024

The Aquatic Club promotes competitive swimming within the Erskine-Skyline-Cupsaw lakes area. We are not a "learn to swim" program, rather we encourage development of racing skills. We hold practices Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday with Meets on Wednesday evening and Saturday mornings from June 21st to August 12th. We will be offering a competitive swim program and a development program ("the 25 club") this year but will cap the latter at 25 participants. If you register for development your child will need to attend a brief assessment before the start of practices.

The swimmers do their part in competition, but the mechanics of a swimming team are also dependent on the parents. Adults set the example for sportsmanship, dependability, enthusiasm and hard work :all the ELAC Board are volunteers. As you register your child to swim you will find important areas of parent contribution that we need you to participate in to run the season. In order for your child to swim with ELAC we require you to indicate a commitment for each of the areas. If for some reason, you are not able to fulfill this commitment it is your responsibility to find a substitute.

Practice Details

- All practices are held at the lanes at Upper Lake in Erskine
- Swimmers will be assigned specific lanes to always swim in to make practice transitions smooth and efficient. They will be told their lane at the first practice
- Please try NOT to approach the coaches with questions during practices we want them to focus their time on coaching your swimmers
- The Presidents will attend as many practices as their work schedules permit!

4:15 - 4:45 : developmental Practice/8 & Under Competitive Team Practice

- Developmental Practice
 - o $\;\;$ Run in three stations- sand (dryland), shallow area, lane 1
 - o 3 Coaches are assigned to Developmental
 - o Purpose of developmental is to move them to the competitive team when they are ready.
 - o Swimmers should move up throughout the summer
- 8 & Under Practice
 - o 3 assigned coaches

- o Use small groups
- o Work on stroke technique- all four strokes are practiced (Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly) along with relays

4.45 - 5.30: 9-10-year-old Practice

- All coaches on the dock
- Small groups
- Work on stroke technique- all four strokes are practiced (Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly) along with relays

5:30 - 6:15: 11-12- year-old Practice

 Work on stroke technique- all four strokes are practiced (Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly) along with relays

6.15 - 7:00: 13 year old and up Practice, Makeup/Conflicts 8:30-9:15am Tuesday, Friday 10 and up

 Work on stroke technique- all four strokes are practiced (Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly) along with relays

Note: we will have a dryland training routine this year based around the beach for weather cancellations if we are able to still be outside but not in the water.

Meet Context

We are part of Lakeland Swim Conference of Northern New Jersey

- Erskine Lakes Aquatic Club is a charter member of LSC since 1960
- Swimmers swim in their age group as of June 1st of the current year
- Swim meets are run according to current USA Swimming codebook
- Officials are present at the meets and will disqualify swimmers who are not swimming with proper swim technique
- "A" standard times are set for all swim events prior to the start of the season.
 - o If a swimmer achieves an "A" time- they are qualified to swim in the Championship Meet at the end of the season
 - o We will circulate A times when they are available in May
- We need to provide timers (that's you!) for our at home and away meets
 - o We show you how to do it and you get a GREAT view of the races!

Meet Details

- Meets are a ton of fun the team and parents truly support each other and cheer everyone on!
- Host lakes will have food and drink available for sale
- For all Meet swimmers need to wear team suit and cap (and we highly recommend goggles)
- There are two types of Meets:
 - Dual against one other lake either at home or away

- o Invitational multi lake with a specific description (details below)
- We understand that you have other commitments and cannot make all meets but the Head
 Coaches need to know in advance when a swimmer cannot make it to meets
 - We recognize that unforeseen circumstances /illness happen but this is known absences in advance e.g. vacations, other sport commitments etc.
 - We are using the Game Changer app to record availability: please download the app https://gc.com/
 - We will add you to the team in the app once we receive your registration and you will receive an email from Game Changer directly.
 - You will NOT be included in meet entries if you have not confirmed attendance on the app by 9am Monday morning before Dual meets and 9am Thursday morning before Invitationals
 - If you have confirmed attendance, you will receive email confirmation from <u>elacswimcoach@gmail.com</u> of the meet entry list (which swimmers are in which events) the day before the meet
 - o If there are any issues to this (last minute illness or other unavoidable situation) please respond as quickly as you can so we can adjust and reissue
- Head coaches will determine which swimmers will swim each event
 - Our goal is to succeed in the meet as a TEAM but also develop and stretch swimmers as individuals
 - This may mean your swimmer does not compete in their "favorite" stroke but we are confident they are capable and prepared for any stroke they are entered in, even if it is a challenge
 - To this goal please do NOT put in requests (beyond the invitational form) as we will not be able to honor them

Dual Meets

- Wednesday Evenings- 6 meets-3 home meets, 3 away meets
- Arrive at 6:15pm and check in with assigned coach
- Warm-ups begin at 6:30 (no diving during warm-ups)
- Meet begins promptly at 7:00pm
- Events are scored and earn points for the team
- Order of events (46 events in a dual meet)
 - o Stroke order is- breaststroke, butterfly, backstroke, freestyle
 - o Boys are odd numbered events, Girls are even numbered events
 - o 8 & Under Relay is a mixed 200M freestyle relay
 - o 9-10, 11-12, 13-14 Boys and Girls have 200M Medley Relay
 - o 15-18 has a mixed 200M Medley Relay
